South Pointe passes 3rd vote

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South Pointe is no longer a "proposed project." It's official.

The 870-acre, mixed-use project received third- and final approval on a planned development zoning change at the City

How the Council meeting + council Monday night, voted. It's the largest planned devel-

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The master-planned community, between U.S. 287 and Texas 360, will include residential, retail, offices and park spaces.

Councilman Tracy Doyle cast the lone dissenting vote on each of the project's three readings.

The council also voted unanimously to sell 81 acres for the Town Square project at U.S. 287 and East Broad Street. The council also voted to purchase 58 acres on Texas 360 and South Miller Road for the relocation of Big League Dreams and the city's aquatic center.

In other business, two landowners can now begin the application process to allow natural gas drilling on land within the Golden Triangle. The council voted 6-1, with councilwoman Linda Hemdon opposing, to grant two variances to the Golden Triangle moratorium. Technological improvements have made natural gas drilling popular in Mansfield.
